Annual Report 2020

1. Introduction

In the year 2020, in view of COVID-19, the Society had to close our premises for a few months during the first half of 2020 and observe the safe-distancing rule and other measures introduced by the Government to prevent the spread of the COVID-19 disease. As a result, most of our activities could only resume in the 2nd half year of 2020 and the number of participants for courses and other activities were reduced to comply with the COVID-19 rules laid down by the Government.

Notwithstanding the above, besides gaining the support from Council of the 3rd Age (C3A) to provide course fee subsidies to seniors who attended courses approved by the National Silver Academy (NSA), we also managed to obtain the support of Skills Future in December 2021 for our NSA approved courses. Course participants are allowed to apply for Skills Future Credit to pay for their course fees for such courses.

In terms of operations and finances, for the financial year ended 31st December 2020, PSS recorded a surplus of S\$2,261,297 for the year as compared to the surplus of S\$129,963 recorded in 2019. Please refer to Paragraph 7 for the detailed explanation of the variance.

2. **Overseas Engagements**

PSS continued to take part in the Kuala Lumpur Photography Festival 2020 (KLPF) as it was held as an on-line event in 2020. PSS members Kim Hui Goh, Dixon Ng Chai Hee and Jeffrey Wong presented in KLPF Online Webinars on 13 September 2020 Sunday 3.30pm to 5.00pm.

The Society continued with its cultural exchange programmes in 2020. The Japan-Singapore Cultural Exchange Exhibition was held in Loke Wan Tho Gallery from 10 to 18 October 2020. The online opening ceremony was attended by Japan International Photographic Federation (JIPF) President Mr Akio Fujii, Secretary General Mr Ichida, Treasurer Ms Okada and Curator Mr Okumoto. PSS was represented by President Mr Goh Kim Hui, Hon. Secretary, Mr Lim Leong Kiat, Asst. Hon. Secretary Ms Liz Liew etc.



3. Talks by Photography Artists and Professionals

In view of COVID-19, PSS had successfully organised the PSS Masterclass Webinar Series in 2020 and invited 16 well-known local and international photographers to share their photography works at the webinar.

PSS also organised a Peranakan Fund Raising Dinner in 2020. The event was conducted via Zoom platform and the program included a photography talk by Mr Lim Leong Kiat on How to Take Better Smartphone Photos and a vocal performance by soprano Ms Lauren Yeo.

4. Exhibitions

After the Circuit Breaker went into Phase 2, these were the following exhibitions held at our Loke Wan Tho Gallery in 2020:

5. Member Engagements & Other Benefits

Our local monthly photography outings for PSS, led by Mr Dixon Ng Chai Hee has been popular with members and non-members; In view of COVID-19 breakout, the outing activities of PSS had to be organised in compliance with the COVID-19 rules and safe distancing measures laid down by the Government. 7. **Finance**

As noted in the introductory remarks, the Society generated a surplus of S\$2,261,297 for the year as compared to the surplus of S\$129,963 recorded in 2019. The increase in surplus was mainly due to a revaluation surplus of S\$2,200,000 recorded for the investment property at 50 Amoy Street partially offset by a lower operating surplus of S\$61,297 recorded for 2020. The latest valuation of 50 Amoy Street property was at S\$8,200,000 as compared to the last valuation of S\$6,000,000 done in 2018. If the revaluation surplus is excluded, the net surplus of S\$61,297 was lower than the previous year's surplus of S\$129,963. The decrease in net surplus was mainly because of lower rental income recorded during the year due to the rental rebates given to the sub-tenants at Selegie Art Centre and the tenant at 50 Amoy Street and the 3-months' rent-free renovation period given to the new tenant of 50 Amoy Street in view of the COVID-19 situation.

8. International Federation of Photographic Art (FIAP)

PSS continues to be recognized by FIAP as the national body representing photographic art in Singapore and retains its Operational Member status of FIAP. PSS manages all applications for FIAP distinctions by local photographers, who have achieved a good track record in international salons. PSS also manage applications for FIAP patronages by local institutions or photographic societies holding international exhibitions in Singapore.

11. Photography Courses

In order to encourage members to further improve their photography skills, the Society introduced new courses such as B&W Fine Art Architecture Photography Course and also continue to promote photography courses for members as well as seniors. Our course income had increased from S\$62,962 in 2019 to S\$68,727 in 2020. From December 2020, participants of NSA approved courses could also use their Skills Future Credit to pay for their course fee.

The Council would like to record its appreciation to the photography instructors and PSS staff for their time and effort in ensuring the effective running of the courses.

12. **67th Singapore International Photography Award 2020**

The 67th Singapore International Photography Awards (SIPA 2020) was chaired by Jack Goh Kok Leong. SIPA 2020 continues to receive strong interest based on the entries received. SIPA 2020 received a total of 8,673 entries by 484 authors originating from 61 Countries.

The PSS Exhibitor Distinctions continues to be well received locally and internationally. The interest in the distinction continues to increase.

13. 5th Lion City International Salon 2020

The 5th Lion City International Salon (LCIS) in Singapore received a total of 8,039 by 467 authors from 58 countries. Thus, re-ascertaining the popularity of LCIS by the global community.



14. 5th Pacific Atlantic International Circuit 2020

The 4th Pacific Atlantic International Circuit (PAIC) 2020 was jointly organised by PSS together with reputable photographic societies in USA and Greece. A total of 9,207 entries was received from 741 authors from 68 countries

15. PSS Staff

The Society would like to record its appreciation for its dedicated staff in their effort to sustain the daily operations and ancillary projects of the Society while ensuring the needs of members are met.
