A semi-retired teacher, Teng Lin started photography 10 years ago, having picked up tips from her teachers, friends and from attending workshops, courses and photo walks. She shoots mainly landscapes, street scenes, buildings and flowers.

She had been invited to share her passion in photography on different platforms such as Leica Academy, MacPherson Photography Club, Kuala Lumpur Photo Festivals, Ministry of Education, National Institution of Education, and Raffles Girls' School where she had taught for 28 years.

In 2022, Teng Lin was part of a team from The Photographic Society of Singapore (PSS) who photographed the winners of The President's Volunteerism & Philanthropy Awards, and her photos were exhibited at The Istana.

In 2023, she contributed to the Photography For Good project, an initiative where PSS partnered with raISE, Singapore Centre for Social Enterprise, to

photograph 21 of their social enterprise members to document and raise awareness for the impactful work that they do.

Teng Lin, a Grade 9 Expert Curator with [1x.com](https://www.1x.com), has more than 131 photos accredited by [1x.com](https://www.1x.com), and published on their website gallery. Among them, 30 photos have been awarded by the head curators who are handpicked by professional gallery curators from well-known institutions such as Sotheby's, Tate Modern Art and others.

She has also won many awards and her photos have been exhibited in Singapore, Kuala Lumpur, Kyoto, Barcelona, Paris and most recently, her photographs were showcased at the Pingyao International Photography Festival, one of the largest photography festivals in the world.
