Twee Liang gradually fell in love with photography since he bought a digital camera in 2012. To further his understanding of photography, he enrolled in a three-month photography course organized by SIM University, and also participated in the photography activities of various photography groups.

He also joined photography groups traveling to China, Thailand, Malaysia and Indonesia for landscape and humanistic photography.

After retirement from his job, his interest in photography deepened. He started taking photos of lotus and animals; and presented them as art instead of ordinary photographs.

In 2020, he registered for the Black & White Fine Art Architecture course conducted by The Photographic Society of Singapore. Thereafter, architecture photography became one of his favorite genres of photography.

Twee Liang was also part of the team from The Photographic Society of Singapore who represented Singapore and won the Gold Medal in the 35th FIAP Black and White Biennial 2022 in Oman, with their series of Black & White Fine Art Architecture photographs called "Concrete Wonders".

His photos have been showcased in The Magic of Black & White Exhibition in 2023.
