

The Photographic Society of Singapore (PSS), in collaboration with Land Transport Authority of Singapore (LTA, together with PSS, the Organisers), is pleased to announce a photography competition to capture the stories and experiences of people in Singapore during their daily journeys as they interact with transport infrastructure and each other.

## **Terms and Conditions**

**1. Title:** LTA Your World in Motion Photography Competition 2026

**2. Theme:** Your World In Motion: Different Lives, Shared Journeys

**3. Entry Category:**

- a) Open Category (18 years old and above)
- b) Junior Category (12-17 years old)

**4. Prizes:**

a) Open Category

- 1<sup>st</sup> Prize: S\$4,000
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize: S\$2,000
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Prize: S\$1,000
- 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> Prizes: S\$500 each
- Honourable Mention: S\$100 x 35 prizes

b) Junior Category

- 1<sup>st</sup> Prize: S\$500
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize: S\$400
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Prize: S\$300
- 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> Prizes: S\$200 each
- Honourable Mention: S\$100 x 15 prizes

c) All winners mentioned above will receive a Certificate of Achievement.

d) Each participant may win only one prize (including Honourable Mentions) in total.

e) Prizes are non-transferable, and non-exchangeable or credit and may be subject to availability. The Organisers reserve the right to substitute any prize with another item of equal or greater value at any time at their sole and absolute discretion, and shall not be liable for any claims arising from such substitutions. Prizes are provided "as is" and without any warranty of any kind, express or implied.

**5. Selection of Winners:**

- a) Submissions will be evaluated by a panel of judges based on
  - Creativity and originality

- Emotional impact and storytelling
  - Technical quality and composition
  - Relevance to the theme
- b) **All decisions made by the panel of judges are final, conclusive, and binding on all participants. No appeals or correspondence will be entertained under any circumstances, and participants hereby waive any right to contest the outcome of the contest.**

## **6. Eligibility:**

- a) The competition is open to Singapore residents only. Singapore residents refer to Singapore Citizens, Permanent Residents, as well as those living in Singapore, including Employment Pass, Work Permit and Dependent Pass holders.
- b) Members and family members of the organizing committees are ineligible to participate.
- c) If you are entering the Junior Category, you must obtain parental consent before entering. By entering the Junior Category, the participant represents and warrants that they have obtained verifiable parental or guardian consent. Winners in the Junior Category must submit proof of parental or guardian consent. The Organisers reserve the right to disqualify any participant who fails to provide sufficient proof of such consent upon request.

## **7. Submission Guidelines:**

- a) There are no participation fees, but participants are to cover all associated costs (e.g. equipment, transport, data).
- b) The competition accepts submissions of photos taken at any time, with no restrictions on the date they were captured.
- c) Photographs must be taken with Mobile Phones/DSLR/Mirrorless cameras. Drone photography is not acceptable.
- d) By entering this competition, participants warrant that the submitted photographs are wholly the original works of the participant, which have not been entered in any other contest/competition, nor published in any medium. Watermarks/logos are strictly prohibited.

- e) Images generated by AI are prohibited. AI-assisted editing tools may be used only for standard photographic post-processing, including exposure adjustment, white balance correction, colour correction, contrast adjustment, sharpening, noise reduction, cropping, and sensor dust removal.

The submitted image must originate from a photograph captured by the participant. No addition, removal, replacement, relocation, or generation of visual elements is permitted. The use of generative AI, content-aware fill, sky replacement, object removal, object insertion, image expansion, compositing, or any other technique that materially alters the original content, scene, or composition of the photograph is prohibited unless expressly permitted by the competition category.

Organisers reserve the right to request the original RAW file or unedited image file for verification.

- f) Submissions can be in color or monochrome.
- g) Image file size per photo:
  - Landscape images: Maximum 1920 pixels in width
  - Portrait images: Maximum 1080 pixels in height
  - Quality: 300 dpi
  - JPEG compression 7-12
  - File Size: 1 MB to 3MB.
- h) Image file format: JPEG only.
- i) Each participant may submit a maximum of five (5) photographs.
- j) Duplicate entries are not permitted and will be disqualified.
- k) Submissions must be uploaded via our official submission portal: <https://www.pss1950.org/your-world-in-motion/>
- l) Participants are responsible to ensure that their submissions are completed and uploaded successfully through the official submission portal by the deadline of 23:59 hours on 30 August 2026, Singapore time. Entries received later than this deadline shall be void. The Organisers shall not be liable for entries lost, delayed, or not received due to technical or other reasons beyond our control.
- m) By submitting your photo, you grant the Organisers a license in respect of the image as set out in the Competition's Terms & Conditions clause 9(f) below.

- n) Organisers reserve the rights to request for the original, high-resolution image file for verification at any time. Failure to provide the file within the stipulated timeframe will result in disqualification.
- o) The Organisers reserve the right to reject or disqualify any submission at their sole and absolute discretion, including but not limited to submissions which breach any term of these Terms and Conditions, are incomplete, do not comply with the contest theme, or are suspected of fraud, infringement, or tampering.

## **8. Announcement of Winners:**

- a) Shortlisted entries will be notified by 15 September 2026 via email. Please note that being shortlisted does not constitute being a final winner. Shortlisted winners must respond to our notification and furnish all required particulars; and where applicable, complete and return any required consent form in order to be considered for the final prize.
- b) Winning entries will be announced on our official website, [www.pss1950.org](http://www.pss1950.org) as well on PSS Instagram account @pss.sg. Winners will also be contacted by email.
- c) Upon notification, winners must email PSS within 72 hours with the following details:

  - Identification number
  - Contact number

  - The highest or full resolution of the image
- d) Winners under 18 must include a copy of the Parent/Guardian's signed consent letter, which must be submitted via email to validate the prize claim. The consent letter can be downloaded from: <https://www.pss1950.org/your-world-in-motion/>
- e) Winners must contact PSS and submit all required documents within 72 hours from the time (time as indicated by the email or messaging systems used) email or direct message has been sent. Failure to do so will result in disqualification and forfeiture of the prize and the Organisers shall be free to deal any unclaimed prize in any manner it sees fit. Prize collection details will be emailed upon receipt of complete information.

## **9. Miscellaneous:**

- a) Participants are absolutely responsible for ensuring their submitted photographs comply with all applicable laws, including the Personal Data

Protection Act (PDPA). Participants acknowledge and agree that the Organisers shall not be liable for any claims, demands, damages, liabilities, proceedings, suits, actions, losses, costs or expenses (including legal fees on a full indemnity basis) arising out of any infringement or violation of the Subject's rights in connection with the submission.

- b) Participants shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Organisers including their affiliates, directors, officers, employees, and agents against any losses, claims, demands, liabilities, costs and expenses (including legal fees on a full indemnity basis), for personal injury or death, loss, damage to property, breach of any obligations, warranty or representation, intellectual property infringement claims, fines and penalties, arising out of or relating to: (i) their participation in the contest; (ii) any breach of these Terms and Conditions; (iii) any violation of applicable laws or rights of a third party, including intellectual property and data protection laws.
- c) The contest and these Terms and Conditions will be governed by Singapore law and participants agree to submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Singapore courts.
- d) A person who is not party to any agreement governed by these Terms and Conditions shall have no rights under the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 2001 to enforce any term of such agreement or these Terms and Conditions.
- e) By participating in the contest or accepting and/or using the prizes, the Participant agrees that the Organisers, their affiliates, officers, agents, and employees shall not be responsible, and no claim relating to any losses or injuries (including special, indirect, incidental and consequential losses) shall be asserted against the Organisers' directors, officers, employees or agents for any and all losses, damages, rights, claims and actions of any kind resulting from the Contest including without limitation, personal injuries, death and property damage, even if advised of the possibility of such damages.
- f) By submitting an entry, participants grant the Organisers a perpetual, worldwide, non-exclusive, royalty-free, sublicensable and transferable license to use, reproduce, modify, adapt, publish, distribute, and publicly display the submitted photographs in any media format and through any media channel, for promotional, marketing, archival, educational, or other purposes related to the contest or the Organisers' operations. Participants waive any right to inspect or approve the use of the entry or receive compensation. Participants acknowledge and consent to the use of their name for the purpose of attribution in connection with the submitted entry.

## **10. Amendments:**

- a) The Organisers reserve the right to amend, modify, suspend, or terminate the contest or any part thereof, including these Terms and Conditions, at any time at their sole and absolute discretion without prior notice or liability. Any amendments shall be binding upon publication on the official contest platforms.

**11. Technical Failures and Force Majeure:**

- a) The Organisers shall not assume any responsibility for any lost, late, misdirected, corrupted, incomplete, illegible, or misdelivered entries, or for any technical, hardware, or software malfunctions, lost or unavailable network connections, or failed, incomplete, delayed, or garbled computer transmissions which may limit a participant's ability to participate in the contest.
- b) The Organisers reserve the right to cancel or modify the contest if fraud, technical failures, or any other circumstances beyond the Organisers' reasonable control arises so as to impair the integrity of the contest.
